

Declaring Operation Andrew 2026

Operation Andrew in our context is all about bringing people to Church to meet with Christ for their salvation, deliverance and breakthroughs, this is what we call a 'Come and See task' – *Luk. 14:17-23*

As it is written, "Andrew first found his own brother Simon ...and brought him to Christ" and he experienced a change of story – *Jhn. 1:40-42*

- Interestingly, Christ is the author of 'Come and See' while John declared Jesus as the Messiah, two of his disciples followed Christ and asked, Rabbi, where dwellest thou? Christ responded; 'Come and See'
- We also saw how Phillip found Nathaniel who initially argued saying 'can any good thing come out of Nazareth? But Phillip insisted 'Come and See' – *Jhn. 1:45-46/47-50*
- While soul winning is a witnessing task, come and see is a soul bringing task – *Jhn. 15:16/ Luk. 14:23*
- While witnessing is taking Christ to the people, Come and see is bringing people to meet with Christ in the church
- While soul winning is preaching the gospel of salvation, come and see is about sharing the testimonies of Christ so as to bring people to have encounter with Him in Church – *Act. 1:8/ Act. 8:4-8*
- While soul winning is gospel message based, come and see is testimony based.
- The following instances of scriptures validate the impact of 'Come and See'
- ✓ The Samaritan woman went to the city proclaiming 'Come and See a man who told me all I ever did and many Samaritan came and believed in Christ – *Jhn. 4:29-30/39-41*
- ✓ The leper that was healed by Christ went about blazing the news around and many came to Christ – *Mrk. 1:40-42/45*
- ✓ The mad man of Gadarenes went about publishing what the Lord has done for him and much more people gathered to Christ when next He came that way – *Mrk. 5:2-3/18-21*
- Note that in the multitude of people is the king's honour

and who ever honours God will be honoured in return
– Pro. 14:28/1Sam. 2:30

- Among others, commitment to ingathering of souls into church makes stars of believers – Dan. 12:3/Luk. 15:4-7
- Every child of God has a come and see responsibility, if he or she is not ashamed of the gospel – Luk. 14:21-23/Mak. 8:38
- Every child of God is redeemed an ambassador of Christ that is, to reconcile people back to God – 2Cor. 5:17-20
- It is also interesting to know that we do not need spiritual maturity in bringing people to Christ, it is purely motivated by one's love for Christ.
- For instance, the Samaritan woman only met Christ once and succeeded in bringing many to Christ same day – Jhn. 4:29-30/39-42
- Therefore, every member is required to target bringing at least one person to church to meet with Christ every 3rd Sunday of the month which is called our Operation Andrew Sunday for an encounter with Christ
- Note: Come and See kicks off this Sunday January 18. 2026
- Note that until a task becomes a must no one can make the most of it, as Christ said "And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd" – Jhn. 10:16
- Bringing people to His fold is a must to Christ and should also mean a must to us
- We must continue to pray for Wisdom in getting people to come – Prov. 11:30.
- We must also stand in prayer to destroy every hold of the devil that might want to resist their coming – Luke 11:21- 22
- Everyone should go after his/her neighbours, colleagues at work, relations and other acquaintances compelling them to come to Christ for their own change of story. – Lk 14:23
- As it is written...and the common people heard him gladly – Mak. 12:37

The supernatural church growth agenda ordained for the year shall deliver with divine speed as every Winner take a strong position in Operation Andrew this year. We should all expect our labour to be openly rewarded in the name of Jesus Christ. Amen.
